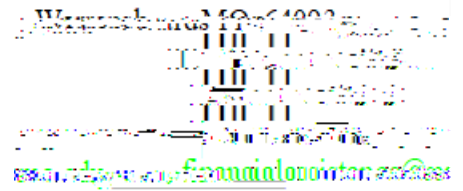

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Eligibility requirements

Applicants must be pursuing their degree and/or alternative certification in an eligible high need teaching field, a 3.25 cumulative GPA, and have submitted a 202 -202 FAFSA to be eligible for the TEACH grant.
